EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING A
STATISTICAL ANALYSIS CENTER WITHIN THE
MONTANA BOARD OF CRIME CONTROL

WHEREAS, the Montana Board of Crime Control has served as the State's criminal justice planning agency since 1968; and

WHEREAS, its mission is to promote public safety by strengthening the coordination and performance of the criminal and juvenile justice system by increasing citizen and public official support and involvement in criminal justice; and

WHEREAS, the statistical analysis of crime data is crucial to justice system improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby create the Montana Criminal Justice Statistical Analysis Center within the Board of Crime Control.

I. PURPOSE

The Center shall be responsible for data collection, data analysis, studies and reporting of all juvenile and adult crime statistics for the state. It will also provide statistical analysis to all other components within the Montana Department of Justice.

II. COMPOSITION

The Center shall be staffed by the administrator of the Montana Board of Crime Control and his professional staff.

III. COMPENSATION

No extra compensation will be given for service to the Statistical Analysis Center.

IV. DURATION


The Center shall exist for a period of two years from the effective date of this Order unless otherwise ordered by subsequent Executive Order. This Order is effective immediately.
