I, THOMAS L. JUDGE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitutions and laws of the State of Montana, do hereby create the Governor's Task Force on Citizen Participation. The Task Force shall:

- (1) develop model rules for the implementation of Montana's citizens' participation statutes;
- (2) provide recommendations on means for encouraging citizen participation in the state government of Montana.

The task force shall have a duration of one year, unless extended by subsequent executive order.


