EXECUTIVE ORDER RECREATING THE
MONTANA HISTORICAL RECORDS ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Public Law 93-536 requires the Governor of each state desiring to participate in the National Historical Publications Program to establish an Historical Records Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, the State of Montana has demonstrated an interest in the care of historical records.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARC RACICOT, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, specifically 2-15-122, MCA, and Public Law 93-536, do hereby recreate the Montana Historical Records Advisory Council.

I. PURPOSE

Pursuant to Public Law 93-536 and the implementing regulations, the Council shall serve as the central advisory body in the State of Montana for the care, storage, and disposition of historical records, and shall review and evaluate grant proposals made to the National Historical -

1 Publications and Records Commission (NHPRC), an Office of the
2 National Archives and Records Administration. The Council is
3 authorized to receive funds pursuant to Public Law 93-536.

4 II. COMPOSITION

5 The names and addresses of members who shall serve at the
6 pleasure of the Governor are submitted by separate letter to
7 the Montana Historical Society and the Secretary of State.

8 III. ADMINISTRATION

9 The Council shall be attached to the Montana Historical
10 Society for administrative purposes.

11 IV. DURATION

12 The Council shall exist for a period of two years from
13 the effective date of this Order unless extended by subsequent
14 Executive Order.

15 This Order is effective October 6, 1994.
