
EXECUTIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING THE
CLARK FORK REHABILITATION ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, on July 12, 1989, a thunderstorm washed metal wastes into the upper Clark Fork drainage, resulting in a large fish kill; and

WHEREAS, thereafter ARCO Coal Company donated \$250,000 for fisheries rehabilitation and \$750,000 for a field demonstration project; and

WHEREAS, a committee is needed to recommend spending decisions for the demonstration project, and

WHEREAS, the demonstration project shall consist of the field construction of any of the following: stream bank stabilization, selective containment, revegetation of tailings, surface water control measures, or any other method determined by this council to be necessary to rehabilitate the upper Clark River project area; and

WHEREAS, this demonstration project shall be complimentary to the existing superfund process, and not a replacement thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana do hereby establish the Clark Fork Rehabilitation Advisory Council.

I. PURPOSE

1. The Clark Fork Rehabilitation Advisory Council shall analyze and make recommendations on the following:
 - a. An optimum location along the upper Clark Fork River for the demonstration project.
 - b. Appropriate technologies that could be used in the project.
 - c. Planning and budgeting.
 - d. Contract implementation and construction.
2. This Council shall prepare and provide quarterly reports to the Governor on expenditures and a status report on the effectiveness of the demonstration project one year after the project has been completed.

3. All rehabilitation work recommendations shall be subject to a 30 day public comment period prior to implementation.
4. All contracting shall be conducted through the Governor's Office, Department of Health and Environmental Sciences, Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks, or Department of Natural Resources and Conservation.
5. This Council and State agencies shall attempt to complete construction of the demonstration project by September 1, 1990.

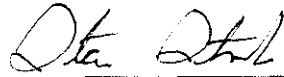
II. COMPENSATION
