EXECUTIVE ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 22-89  
CREATING AN EDUCATION COMMISSION FOR THE NINETIES

---

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of September, 1989, Executive Order 22-89 was issued establishing an Education Commission for the Nineties;

WHEREAS, paragraph II of Executive Order 22-89 provides for the appointment of Commission members;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State to increase the membership from 11 to 14 members, so as to provide a fair, geographic representation on the Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, including Section 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby:

1. Amend Executive Order 22-89 to increase the Education Commission membership from 11 to 14 members;
