EXECUTIVE ORDER CONTINUING THE MONTANA LEWIS & CLARK
TRAIL ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 23-89 created the Montana Lewis and Clark Trail Advisory Council;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 23-89 composition of members contains errors in the make-up of the membership of the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STAN STEPHENS, Governor of the State of Montana, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, specifically 2-15-122, MCA, do hereby amend Executive Order No. 23-89, the Lewis & Clark Trail Advisory Council and direct that the composition shall be amended as follows:
