

BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY COMMITTEE

January 5, 1977

The first meeting of the Business and Industry Committee was called to order this date, at 4:00 P.M., in Room 434, of the Capitol Building, with Chairman Vincent presiding. All members were present with the exception of Representatives Bradley and Quilici, who were excused.

Chairman Vincent stated, regarding the use of television equipment and any recording devices (whether used by news media or by private parties) that such use will be permitted by the committee if it is orderly and in place before the committee convenes and is not a detriment to a fair and orderly committee hearing. Permission for such television or recording devices must be obtained from the chairman for each meeting and will be excluded upon objection of one committee member.

Mr. Bob Tyler was introduced to the members as the Staff Attorney, and would be available to them.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:25 P.M.
