
PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND SAFETY COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS:


A meeting of the House Public Health, Welfare and Safety Committee was held Thursday, January 6, 1977 on adjournment of the House in Room 428A of the State Capitol. Chairman Red Menahan being excused, Vice-Chairman Polly Holmes called the meeting to order. A quorum was present, and all absent members were deemed excused by unanimous agreement.

All members present introduced themselves. Vice-Chairman Holmes informed the Committee that Charlotte Solan would be the Committee Aide and that the Committee would also have access to a lawyer from the Legislative Council by the name of Bob Pyfer. It was pointed out that Rep. Gary Kimble was also a lawyer.

Vice-Chairman Holmes suggested that Committee members study HOUSE BILL 30 over the weekend as the public hearing on it would be held at the next meeting of the Committee, on Tuesday, January 11. HOUSE BILLS 52 and 61 will be transferred to the Subcommittee on Problems of the Elderly.
