TAXATION COMMITTEE

Rep. Herb Huennekens, Chairman, called the meeting to order in room 434 of the Capitol Building, Helena, January 6, 1977, at 8:00 a.m. All members of the committee were present.

Robert Marks, Roger Tippy, Bob McGee, Dean Zinnecker, Steve Turkiewicz, Dennis Burr were among those present.

Robert Marks, sponsor of House Bill 20, explained this bill provides for changes brought about by recodification requirements. He asked Roger Tippy, attorney for the Legislative Council, to explain the grammatical corrections shown on the introduced copy of the bill. He explained

20 Dennis Burr brought to the attention of the committee that
 the language on page 18, section 12, 84-5606.18 needs clarifying. Mr. Tippy was requested to write language correcting this language.


On page 3, lines 6-15 were deleted with veterans' approval since the trust fund was no longer beneficial; also, solvent funds are no longer liable for taxation.

Robert Marks, sponsor, advised House Bill 26 is also a recodification bill dealing with Title 84 taxation laws. To correct a typo on page 4, section 2, line 3 is amended following "revenue", strike "9fu". Roger Tippy

HOUSE BILL explained other changes in this bill to the committee.
