

## EDUCATION COMMITTEE

February 1, 1977

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m., with all members present except Reps. Barrett, Kvaalen and Lund, who came in later. The meeting was for the purpose of taking executive action on several bills.

House Bill 119 - Rep. Hand moved that the bill DO NOT PASS. Rep. Courtney made a substitute motion that the bill DO PASS. Rep. Lory moved to amend page 1, line 22, by striking "2 mills" and inserting "1 mill." The motion to amend was passed 7-5 (3 absent). Rep. Courtney then moved that HB 119 DO PASS AS AMENDED. The motion passed 11-1 (3 absent).

House Bill 305 - Rep. Kessler moved that the bill DO PASS. He amended his motion to amend the bill on page 2, line 11, after "normally" to strike "offered in curricula of" and insert "required for graduation from". After discussion, he changed his motion to simply add "basic" on line 11 before "curricula." The motion to amend was voted on and passed with all present voting YES except Rep. Estenson. (Rep. Kessler then moved DO PASS AS AMENDED. There was more discussion about how the money would be received and distributed (page 3). A suggestion was made to put it in as a line item in an appropriation bill, but Rae Haas said that it would not be codified if placed there. Rep. Lory moved to table the bill until research can be done on these problems. His motion passed unanimously.

House Bill 391 - Rep. Kessler moved that the bill DO PASS. There was discussion on whether it really gives more representation because a person does not have to live in a district in order to run for election there. Rep. Kessler said the people in the district have the option to vote for him or not. Rep. Lund made a substitute motion that HB 391 DO NOT PASS. Rep. Gunderson asked if Rep. Kessler would change page 2, line 13 to 10% instead of 5%. Rep. Kvaalen asked who would determine what the population in a district is; is it to be tied to census figures. If so, this means changing district boundaries. Rep. Gunderson made a motion for all motions pending that HB 391 be tabled. The motion passed 9-6.

House Bill 404 - Rep. Barrett moved that the bill DO PASS. The motion passed unanimously.

House Bill 409 - Rep. Barrett moved to add an immediate effective date in the title and at the end of the bill, and AS SO AMENDED, DO PASS. The motion passed unanimously.

House Bill 410 - Rep. Dussault moved to table the bill for purposes of amending it. The motion passed unanimously.

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House Bill 416 - Rep. Hand moved that the bill DO PASS. There was a long discussion on whether this law will do anything positive toward stopping the practice of selling and buying term papers. The motion failed 6-9. Rep. Gunderson then moved HB 416 DO NOT PASS. Without objection, the vote was reversed and Rep. Gunderson's motion passed 9-6.

House Bill 443 - Rep. Barrett moved to place this bill in a subcommittee to try to write in some kind of waiver of liability for school boards so they can give written reasons for dismissal of non-tenured teachers. The motion passed 10-5. The Chairperson appointed Reps. Barrett, Eudaily and Estenson to the subcommittee.

House Bill 448 - Rep. Barrett moved that the bill DO PASS. After a short discussion, the motion passed 10-5.

House Joint Resolution 18 - The Chairperson said she would like to table this resolution because there is another with the same intent introduced by Rep. Driscoll. Rep. Bradley agreed to hold the resolution. Rep. Barrett moved to table HJR 18. The motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
