

JUDICIARY COMMITTEE

EXECUTIVE SESSION  
February 2, 1977

Following the short break the committee then went into executive session. All members were present except Representatives Hand and Dussault.

CHAIRMAN SCULLY appointed a sub-committee to study House Bills 456 and 556, consisting of Representatives Seifert, Chairman, Conroy and McLane. They will report on Friday, the 4th.

MR. SCULLY stated they would hold House Bill #353, which had been scheduled for hearing this day.

CHAIRMAN SCULLY reported on House Bill #81. The leadership asked that they pull it back and consider a committee bill be submitted instead. He asked the committee to table House Bill #81.

HOUSE BILL #81:

REPRESENTATIVE LORY moved to table. The motion passed with the vote unanimous.

REPRESENTATIVE LORY moved to have a committee bill prepared to amend 95-610 on House Bill #81. The second was made and the motion carried with the vote unanimous.

CHAIRMAN SCULLY appointed a sub-committee to study the mandatory insurance bills, House Bill 316 and House Bill 313, sponsored by Representative Fagg and E. Gunderson, respectively.
