

JUDICIARY COMMITTEE
EXECUTIVE SESSION

February 17, 1977

The executive session was called to order by Chairman Scully following the regular meeting of the Judiciary Committee in room 436 of the Capitol Building, Helena, Montana on Thursday, at 11:20 a.m. All members were present except Representatives Colburn, Roth and Eudaily.

REPRESENTATIVE ROTH came in.

HOUSE BILL 77:

REPRESENTATIVE ROTH moved to amend by striking section 6 in its entirety. The motion carried with the vote unanimous. It was decided, after discussion to postpone further action until the committee had more time to study the ramifications.

HOUSE BILL 495:

REPRESENTATIVE DAY reported from the water sub-committee a "do pass" on this bill. REPRESENTATIVE LORY moved adoption of the committee report. The motion carried with the vote unanimous.

HOUSE BILL 496:

REPRESENTATIVE DAY reported from the water sub-committee "do not pass". REPRESENTATIVE HAND moved adoption of the committee report. The motion carried with REPRESENTATIVE RAMIREZ voting "no".

HOUSE BILL 560:

REPRESENTATIVE DAY reported from the water sub-committee "do not pass". REPRESENTATIVE KEYSER moved to adopt the committee report. The motion carried with REPRESENTATIVE RAMIREZ voting "no".
