

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

February 21, 1977

The meeting was called to order at 10:55 a.m., with all members present except Rep. Kessler, who was excused.

House Joint Resolution 72 was discussed first. Rep. Dussault, sponsor, explained that the resolution contains the intent of HJR 16, which was heard earlier. Responsibility is placed equally on OSPI and the Governor's Office for coordination of children's services for children who need special care and services.

Rep. Barrett moved that HJR 72 DO PASS. The motion passed unanimously.

House Bill 768 - There was general discussion on which schools this bill would affect. It seems to be the Rocky Boy School. Rep. Hand moved that the bill DO NOT PASS AS AMENDED. The motion passed 11-3.

House Bill 744 - Rep. Estenson submitted the attached amendment. She moved that the committee adopt the amendment. Rep. Lory made a substitute motion that the bill DO NOT PASS as unamended. The substitute motion passed 9-5.

House Bill 707 - Rep. Lory moved that the bill DO NOT PASS. The Chairperson said Dr. Daton's testimony was unauthorized by Dr. Pettit, but Dr. Pettit's rebuttal letter was unsigned. Rep. Lory said that that testimony had not affected his vote on the bill. The program was supposed to have been phased out. Page 168 in the Executive Budget Book deals with this program, and that is what it states. The motion DO NOT PASS failed 5-8. Rep. Kennerly then moved that the bill DO PASS AS AMENDED. The vote was reversed and the motion passed 8-5. Rep. Dussault made a motion to strike lines 15 and 16 on page 1, and to renumber subsequent subsections. The motion passed unanimously.

House Bill 578 - Rep. Meyer moved to table the bill. The motion passed 11-1 (Rep. Courtney voted NO, 3 excused).

House Bill 365 - Rep. South had stated that the actual dollar amount required under this bill is \$58 million. There is no ceiling on the statewide deficiency levy. One mill raises \$1.5 million statewide. Rep. Estenson moved that the bill DO PASS. Rep. Gunderson made a substitute motion that the bill be amended to increase the schedules to what the Legislative Fiscal Analyst projected. The substitute motion passed 12-2-1. Rep. Gunderson then moved that the bill DO PASS AS AMENDED. The motion passed 12-2-1.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 11:55 a.m.
