

JUDICIARY COMMITTEE

EXECUTIVE SESSION
February 23, 1977

The House Judiciary Committee met for executive session at 7:00 a.m. Wednesday, February 23, 1977 in room 436 of the Capitol Building, Helena, Montana. Representative John Scully presided. All members were present, with the exception of Day, Conroy, Kennerly and Teague.

HOUSE BILL #647:

REPRESENTATIVE RAMIREZ reported on the proposed amendments. He moved their adoption. The motion carried with the vote unanimous. It was decided to withhold action until the following day when the amendments would be typed and a copy presented to each member.

HOUSE BILL #316:

REPRESENTATIVE RAMIREZ reported on the progress of the amendments as proposed for this bill. Action had been taken in an earlier meeting but it was decided the amendments would require too much work and even then the bill would be unworkable.

REPRESENTATIVE RAMIREZ moved "do not pass".

The motion carried with Representatives Dussault and Holmes voting "no".

HOUSE BILL #761:

REPRESENTATIVE SEIFERT moved "do not pass".

The motion carried with the vote 9 to 5.
