

FISH AND GAME COMMITTEE

March 17, 1977

The meeting was called to order at 11:10 a.m., with all members present except Reps. Tropila and Barrett, who were excused.

The Committee went into Executive Session to consider bills.

Senate Bill 203 - Rep. Baeth discussed the attached amendments. Rep. Seiffert moved that they be adopted. The motion passed unanimously. Rep. Baeth then moved that the bill BE CONCURRED IN AS AMENDED. The motion passed unanimously. Rep. Johnston then requested that an exception be made in the case of wasting mountain lion and bear meat. The request was treated as a motion, and passed unanimously. The bill will except the meat of these two animals from the wasting prohibition. Rep. Baeth will carry the bill on the floor of the House.

Senate Bill 242 - The Chairman placed this bill into a subcommittee composed of Rep. Johnston, chairman, Reps. Conroy and Ellis. They will study the bill and report back to the committee.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
