EDUCATION COMMITTEE

March 23, 1977

The meeting was called to order at 4:45 p.m., with all members present except Reps. Gilligan and Estenson, who were excused, and Reps. Kennerly, Uhde, and Lund, who were absent.

Chairperson Dussault stated that Rep. Marks has requested that the Committee hold House Bill 699. Rep. Gunderson moved that the bill be tabled. The motion passed. Rep. Lory then moved to place it inaa subbommittee to be worked on rather than tabling it. The motion passed. The Chairperson appointed Rep. Lory, Chairman, Reps. Eudaily, Gunderson and Dussault to the subcommittee.

House Bill 365 was discussed. Rep. Hand moved to reconsider earlier action taken on the bill. The motion was discussed at length and then passed 7-5. (Reps. Estenson and Gilligan had submitted written votes on the motion). Rep. Gunderson then moved to strip the previous Education Committee amendments from the bill. This means the bill would be in its original form. The motion was discussed at length and the following schedule was also discussed:
