

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

April 8, 1977

The meeting was called to order at 10 a.m., with all members present except Reps. Gilligan, Barrett, Kvaalen and Meyer, who were absent.

Chairperson Dussault explained that House Joint Resolution was introduced to request a study of vocational education program governance. She said that it might not be necessary if House Bill 69 would be revived and passed in the Senate. After some discussion, Rep. Hand moved that the resolution DO PASS. The committee decided that the resolution should be passed because it is not known if HB 69 will make it.

The committee discussed a study of the whole governance of education and creating an education oversight committee.

Rep. Hand's motion was voted on and passed unanimously by those present.

The Chairperson mentioned a meeting Monday morning, which is necessary to deal with bills left in the committee.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:02 a.m.
