PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND SAFETY COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS:

A meeting of the House Public Health, Welfare and Safety Committee was held Thursday, April 14, 1977, at 11:30 a.m. in room 437 of the State Capitol building. Chairman Red Menahan called the meeting to order. A quorum was present.

Chairman Menahan stated that HB 840, was the bill that had been drafted by the committees request.

Mr. Melby explained that the only way they would support HB 840 was if HJR 101 was tabled or killed. If both bills were accepted the Senate would have to suspend the rules and the resolution would be unnecessary. He then stated that they maintained that they have the authority to adopt rules now.

Representative Lynch moved HB 840, be indefinitely postponed. The motion was passed with Representatives Porter and Vinger opposed.

Representative Lynch moved HJR 101, be indefinitely postponed. The motion was passed with Representatives Cox, Vinger, and Porter opposed.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:50 a.m.
