MINUTES

JOINT RULES COMMITTEE

The Joint Rules Committee met in room 331 of the capitol on January 20, 1977. Senator Terry Murphy called the meeting to order at 3:20 p.m. He stated that this meeting was called so that House members could explain their amendments to SJR 1, and that no official action would be taken. Because of this, the minutes were not approved or the roll call taken.

Senator Murphy turned the meeting over to Representative Meloy to explain the amendments. During his presentation, he stated that the House felt they would prefer amending the rules, instead of suspending the rules. Of the proposed amendments, he said they were most interested in the extension of introduction of bills. Questions and a general discussion was held after his presentation.

After the discussion, Senator Murphy asked the members to individually think about the amendments. He then said that no official action could be taken in the Joint Rules Committee until the Senate had acted on these amendments on the floor.

Representative Bradley then said that she strongly favored amendment 4, and that she felt it was a good compromise.

Senator McOmber then tossed an idea for the group to think about.

He thought that the rules could be amended to read: by approval of

2/3 of the rules committee, the deadline of introduction of committee

bills could be extended in the House in question.
