MONTANA STATE SENATE


The first meeting of the Business and Industry Committee was called to order by Chairman Frank Hazelbaker on the above date in Room 404 of the State Capitol Building at 11:00 a.m.

ROLL CALL: All members were present.

Chairman Hazelbaker introduced Roger Tippy, Legislative Attorney and Mimi Fancher, Secretary of the Business and Industry Committee.

Chairman Hazelbaker stated there was a proposed piece of legislation brought to him by John Cadbury of the Montana Banker's Association entitled "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINES AND POINT OF SALE TERMINALS AS ELECTRONIC BANKING FACILITIES AND ELECTRONIC TRANSFERS OF FUNDS BY BANKS." After discussion of the Committee, it was agreed that everyone would give more thought to this proposed legislation and it would be discussed again Thursday, January 6, to decide whether or not it would be introduced.
