

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

January 27, 1977

The meeting was called to order at 3:20 p.m. by Senator Towe, Chairman, in Room 410 of the Capitol Building. Committee members present were Senators Towe, Rasmussen, Story, Jergeson, Blaylock and Devine, with Senator Brown absent.

The following bills were discussed: SB 104

SB 106

SB 107

SB 101

The following action was taken during executive session:

SB 104 Senator Blaylock moved to amend the bill (see amendments on attached committee report). THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY WITH SENATOR BROWN ABSENT.

Senator Rasmussen moved to amend p.2 line 11 by striking "business" and inserting "calendar".

THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY WITH SENATORS TOWE AND BROWN NOT VOTING.


Senator Blaylock moved the bill Do Pass As Amended.

SB 106     It was decided to ask John Hollow, Committee Counsel,  
to research the title further and the bill was  
passed for the day.

SB 107 After discussion, it was determined the bill merely restored the \$500. Senator Story moved SB 107 Do Pass. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

SB 101 It was felt if all rules adopted during the interim were to be examined during session, it would necessitate annual sessions or at least 180 day sessions. The committee asked the committee counsel to research the bill for possible amendments.


