### MINUTES OF MEETING SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE January 29, 1977

The meeting of this committee was called to order on the above date by Senator Turnage, Chairman, at 9:40 a.m. in Room 415 of the State Capitol Building.

#### ROLL CALL:

All members of the committee were present for this meeting.

#### WITNESSES PRESENT TO TESTIFY:

Tom Honzel - Deputy County Attorney, Lewis & Clark County Senator Tom Hager - District 30

## CONSIDERATION OF SENATE BILL 176:

Senator Murray, co-sponsor of this bill with Senator Regan, explained the purpose of the bill to the committee, saying that it would give a 20-day period after a divorce before it became final.

There were no proponents or opponents of the bill present to testify.

#### DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 176:

Senator Warden moved that Senate Bill 176 DO PASS. The motion carried unanimously.

### CONSIDERATION OF SENATE BILL 180:

Senator Tom Hager, District 30, sponsor of this bill, told the committee that the county attorneys had assured him it was a simple bill.

Tom Honzel, Deputy County Attorney of Lewis & Clark County, representing the County Attorneys Association, said that the only thing this bill actually does is add the words "or concealment of merchandise" which should clarify the law.

Since there were no other proponents or opponents present to testify, the Chairman allowed the committee to ask questions of Mr. Honzel.

#### DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 180:

Senator Roberts moved to strike section 1 in its entirety and, as so amended, DO PASS.

Senator Regan moved as a substitute motion that S.B.  $180\ \text{DO}\ \text{NOT}$  PASS.

Senator Roberts then moved as a substitute motion for all motions pending that consideration be passed for the day. This motion carried unanimously.

### CONSIDERATION OF SENATE BILL 119:

Joan Mayer, Legislative Council attorney, went over the amendments she had prepared on this bill.

Senator Ragen moved that the committee reconsider their previous action in passing S.B. 119 as amended. This motion carried unanimously.

#### DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 119:

Senator Ragen moved the adoption of the amendments prepared by Joan Mayer. The motion carried unanimously.

Senator Warden moved that S.B. 119 as amended DO PASS. The motion carried unanimously.

### CONSIDERATION OF SENATE BILL 34:

The Legislative Council attorney, Joan Mayer, went over the amendment she had prepared to page 95 and the repealers for the committee.

Senator Towe moved the adoption of the repealers. Motion carried.

#### DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 34:

Senator Roberts moved that S.B. 34 as amended DO PASS. The motion carried unanimously.

The attorney from the Council is to prepare all amendments passed on Senate Bill 34 in order that the committee may look them over before the Committee Report is filed.

The Chairman asked that Joan call Tom Stoll for his suggested amendments on S.B. 115 for Monday, January 31, 1977. He also tentatively set S.B. 156 consideration for Monday, along with further consideration of Senate Bills 27 and 33.

#### DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 23:

Senator Olson moved that S.B. 23 DO NOT PASS. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business before the committee, the committee adjourned at 10:55 a.m..
