

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
SENATE STATE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE
FEBRUARY 11, 1977

The meeting was called to order by Senator Towe, Chairman, at 4:00 p.m. in Room 410 of the Capitol Building. Committee members present were Senators Towe, Story, Brown, Rasmussen, Roskie, Jergeson, Blaylock and Devine.

The following bills were discussed: HB 185
 SB 83
 Governor's Appointments

HOUSE BILL 185

Senator Blaylock moved the amendments to the bill (see attached committee report). THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY WITH SENATORS STORY, ROSKIE, AND BROWN ABSENT.

Senator Jergeson moved House Bill 185 Do Pass As Amended. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY WITH SENATORS STORY AND ROSKIE ABSENT.

SENATE BILL 83

Senator Jergeson moved to strike section 6 in its entirety and renumber the subsequent sections. THE MOTION CARRIED WITH SENATOR RASMUSSEN VOTING NO AND SENATOR DEVINE ABSENT.

Senator Rasmussen moved to amend the title following "77-2305," by inserting "and" and following "77-2307," by striking "and 77-2308,". He also included in that motion the amendments to page 31 identical to the above on lines 8 and 9. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY WITH SENATOR DEVINE ABSENT.

Senator Story moved to pass further action on Senate Bill 83 for the day. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY WITH SENATOR DEVINE ABSENT.

APPOINTMENTS - WAMBACH

Senator Towe reported the audit of the Forestry School will not be available for approximately 4 weeks. Senator Roskie commented Dr. Wambach has a good background for the appointment as Director of Fish and Game although he has a hot temper. He has fair administrative skills and likes to be on the cutting edge of things.

Senator Devine moved that Dr. Wambach be confirmed as the Fish and Game Director. THE MOTION FAILED WITH SENATOR DEVINE VOTING YES AND SENATORS TOWE, STORY, BROWN, RASMUSSEN, ROSKIE, JERGESON, AND BLAYLOCK VOTING NO.

Senator Brown moved the Chairman contact President Bowers of the University at the first opportunity and tell him the committee wants the audit as soon as possible as they are waiting to confirm the appointee for the

results of the audit. He also suggested the same message be relayed to the Governor. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.


APPOINTMENTS - LACKMAN

(c) a county high school district having a student enrollment less than 2,000."

Insert: "The provisions of this section do not apply to candidates for the office of trustee of a school district, their political committees, and political committees organized to support or oppose a school district issue when the school district is:

(a) a first-class district located in a county having a population less than 15,000;

(b) a second or third-class district; or

(c) a county high school district having a student enrollment less than 2,000."
