MINUTES OF MEETING SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE March 30, 1977

The meeting of this committee was called to order by Senator Turnage, Chairman, on the above date at 9:45 a.m. in Room 442 of the State Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL:

All members of the committee were present except Senator Roberts who was excused to attend another hearing.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

HB 498 - Sen. Turnage offered amendments to this bill for consideration by the committee. Sen. Towe then moved the adoption of all of the amendments. (See Attach. #1) Sen. Lensink voted "No" on amendment #9. Other than the one "No" vote on amendment #9, the motion carried unanimously. Sen. Olson then moved that HB 498 as amended BE CONCURRED IN. The motion carried unanimously.

HB 457 - Sen. Olson moved the adoption of the amendments. (See Attach. #2) The motion carried unanimously. Sen. Towe then moved that HB 457 as amended BE CONCURRED IN. The motion carried unanimously.

At this time, Senators Towe and Warden were excused to attend other meetings. (10:00 a.m.) Sen. Towe returned as the meeting was delayed.

HB 200 - Sen. Olson moved that HB 200 be tabled. The motion carried unanimously.

HB 782 - Sen. Regan moved that HB 782 BE NOT CONCURRED IN. The motion carried with Senators Lensink and Olson voting "No". The vote was 5 - 2 with Towe, Turnage, Murray, Regan and Warden voting "Yes". Sen. Warden's vote on this bill was obtained during the afternoon session of the Senate as she was excused from this meeting before this vote. Sen. Roberts was also excused during this meeting.

HB 334 - Sen. Lensink moved to strike section 3, subsection (2), and section 4, following "filed". The motion carried unanimously. (The committee will act on this bill at the meeting on 3/31/77.)

There being no further business before the committee at this time, the committee adjourned at 11:05 a.m..
