Senator Blaylock moved to confirm the appointees to the Board of Public Education. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.


Senator Brown moved to confirm the appointees to the Board of Electricians. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
