All committee members were present except Senators Regan and Roberts who were excused to attend other meetings.


EXECUTIVE SESSION

HB 654 - After discussion by the committee, Sen Towe moved that HB 654 BE CONCURRED IN. The motion carried unanimously. The committee stipulated that Senator Turnage is to request that HB 654 be referred to the Finance & Claims Committee after the Judiciary committee report is read.

HB 738 - Sen. Towe moved the adoption of the attached amendments. (See Attach. #1) The motion carried unanimously. He then moved that HB 738 as amended BE CONCURRED IN. The motion carried unanimously.

Respectfully report as follows: That HOUSE Bill No. 738, the child reading bill, be amended as follows:

1. Amend page 11, section 5, lines 12 through 16.

Following: "offenders,"

Strike: "Whenever the peace officer believes, on reasonable grounds, that the youth must be detained, the peace officer must notify the probation officer immediately and the probation officer's approval for detention is required prior to detaining the youth."

Insert: "Whenever the peace officer believes, on reasonable grounds, that the youth must be held in custody, then the peace officer must notify the probation officer without undue delays, and shall, as soon as practicable, provide the probation officer with a written report of his reasons for holding that youth in custody. If it is necessary to hold the youth pending appearance before the youth court, then the youth must be held in some place that has been approved by the youth court and is completely separated from adult offenders."
