### MINUTES OF THE MEETING EDUCATION COMMITTEE MONTANA STATE SENATE

April 12, 1977

The thirty-seventh meeting of the Senate Education Committee was called to order by Senator Chet Blaylock, Chairman, on the above date, in Room 402 of the State Capitol Building at 11:00 o'clock A. M.

ROLL CALL: All members of the Committee were present.

CONSIDERATION OF HOUSE BILL No. 378: An act amending Section 75 7018, R.C.M., to increase the schedule of reimbursement for school buses.

Representative Porter, Billings, District 65, sponsor of the Bill, was called on to present his testimony. He stated the situation that school bus transportation is in under the present funding of partially state reimbursed and the balance paid by the local districts by property taxes. That a House amendment reduced the reimbursement rate to 40 cents for the first year of the biennium and 45 cents for 1979 which does not come up to half of the actual cost of running a school bus and most counties are in a bind on their tax levies already.

Proponents of the Bill included:

Rob Stockton, OSPI, who had prepared a graph showing the cost of bus transportation per mile per bus capacity, how costs had increased over the past several years and that the major portion was being paid by the districts. Total average cost in 1975 for operation of a 45 passenger school bus was \$1.25; and that since transportation costs must be paid, people really do not have any vote on it.

There was no opposition to the Bill.

In closing, Rep. Porter mentioned an article in the Billings Gazette where school bus contractors were trying to get out from under a bus contract because they could not make anything at \$1.10 per mi.

Questions by the Committee related to the cost factors, with Senator Fasbender stating the transportation appropriation had been put in at 45 cents and he knew of no way to raise it.

The Chair closed the hearing of House Bill 378.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL No. 365: Considerable discussion of the school foundation schedule centered on the advisability of amending the schedule to an amount the districts could get by with,

and what would be the best course of action as to commensurate local levy increases or a state-wide deficiency levy to fund the foundation program. Differences in the financing statements offered by the offices of Mike Billings as compared to John LaFaver's were also discussed. Lloyd Markell, MEA, and Bob Stockton, OSPI, advised the Committee of the reasons for funding at the highest possible figure; and Senator Dunkle commented that if they were looking at a deficiency of \$10 million, why not take the \$10 million necessary from the Governor's Homestead Act. Senator Smith suggested using the \$12 million surplus funds the State had, to which Senator Fasbender stated it must be left because of margin of error and in case revenue doesn't meet expenses if an error were to occur.

Senator McCallum moved that House Bill 365 be amended to an increase of 8% for each year of the coming biennium; motion was seconded and carried by majority vote with Senator Fasbender and Senator Dunkle dissenting.

Senator McCallum moved that House Bill 365 AS AMENDED, BE CON-CURRED IN; motion was seconded and carried by majority vote, with Senator Fasbender abstaining and Senator Dunkle voting "no". Senator Blaylock will carry the Bill in the floor. Amendments on the School Foundation Program schedule are as shown on the attached copy of the Standing Committee Report.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL No. 378: Senator Thomas moved that House Bill 378 BE CONCURRED IN; motion was seconded and carried by unanimous vote. Senator Fasbender will carry the Bill on the floor.

Senator Fasbender announced he would make a motion on the floor after Second Reading to bring out HB 69.

### ADJOURNMENT:

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:00 P.M.
