MINUTES

SENATE RULES COMMITTEE

The Senate Rules Committee met on April 18, 1977 in room 331 of the capitol. Senator Stephens called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. All members were present. Also present was Diana Dowling, Legislative Council and Senator Goodover.

Senator Stephens said that under discussion today were three bills. HJR 106, HB 39 and HB 31.

Senator Mathers moved that HJR 106 be accepted and that it be assigned to second reading. Motion seconded by Senator Thiessen and approved by a voice vote unanimously.

Senator Murphy moved that HB 39 be referred to second reading with the recommendation that it be concurred in. This motion was also approved unanimously by a voice vote.

Diana Dowling briefly explained House Bill 31. She stated that because another bill had been killed, they had to bring this bill back because it is a recod bill.

Senator Goodover then spoke. He stated that the main reason that he moved that it come to the Rules Committee was that it had the same language as 304, and he thought it could not be considered.

A motion was made and approved unanimously that the Rules Committee recommend to the Senate that vote of 2/3 majority to take action on \$\mathbb{8}\$ 31 be made and that if it passes, it be placed on second reading.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:15 p.m.
