The following bill was discussed: HB 799


HOUSE BILL 799

Representative Scully, District 76, sponsor of the bill, stated the bill appropriates \$50,000 to the Department of Administration for the protection of works of art in the Capitol. He cited special concern for the Paxton paintings in the House lobby and the Charles Russell painting in the House Chambers. He said deterioration has already damaged them and abuse from vandals is an ever present threat. He stated the funds are too low, but would allow a start on the project and would be taken from the earmarked revenue fund.

There were no proponents and no opponents to the bill and the hearing was closed.

Senator Jergeson moved House Bill 799 Be Concurred In. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned to reconvene at the 46th session of the Legislature.
