Introductions were made with Gene Frates as Vice-Chair and time-keeper and Ms. Betty Schutt acting as assistant to Budd Gould.


Chairman Holmes suggested to all members that if there is a sub-committee that they were interested in serving on to notify her of which ones and she will do her best to accommodate all.

RULES OF PROCEDURE
HOUSE PUBLIC HEALTH COMMITTEE

- 1) All individuals wishing to testify must sign the witness sheet prior to the committee hearing.
- 2) Sponsor of the bill will open and close the presentation.
- 3) Proponents will speak first, followed by opponents, the time subject to limitation of the chair.
- 4) All questions will be put forth by the committee. No questions shall be directed between proponents or opponents.
- 5) All discussion will commence at the direction of the chair.
- 6) Questions by committee members shall be directed to proponents and opponents at the close of the presentation unless otherwise authorized by the chair.
- 7) Amendments to the committee must be presented in writing.
- 8) Anyone wishing to smoke, please do so in the hallway.
