HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS:

A Human Services Committee Meeting was held January 10, 1979, in the Capitol Annex room #20. The meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m. by Chairman Polly Holmes and all members were present except Rep. Robert J. Pavlovich.

A group of bills were discussed which didn't have sponsors yet, and requested that anyone interested in carrying these bills should please do so. It was recommended that Freshmen members carry some of the bills for experience in learning the techniques of legislative sponsorship.

Mr. Duane Roberts, Solid Waste Manager, brought a pre-filed bill, House Bill #34, in need of a sponsor. Mr. Roberts explained the necessity of the bill and Rep. Gene Frates offered to be the sponsor of this bill.

There was a bill brought to the attention of this committee by the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences to adopt and enforce rules for the control of communicable diseases and transportation of dead human bodies. Rep. Andrea Hemstad offered to sponsor the bill.

A proposed mobile home re-evaluation bill was discussed and the consensus of the committee was that it didn't involve Human Services, there would be an economic trade-off with higher taxes, and that perhaps the person suggesting such a bill should pursue other avenues to introduce it.

The standing sub-committee plan was introduced and the members and their committees are outlined on the attached sheet.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:00 by Chairman Holmes.
