EDUCATION COMMITTEE

Minutes of Meeting

An Executive Session of the Education Committee was called to order at 1:30 p.m., Wednesday, January 17, 1979 in Room 5, Capitol Annex by Chairman Peter J. Gilligan.

The purpose of the meeting was to take action on House Bills 105 and 107 which were heard Monday, January 15, 1979.

The roll was called. Fred (Fritz) Daily and Oscar S. Kvaalen, were excused. All other members were present.

It was announced by the Chairman that Representative Burnett had requested action be postponed on House Bill 105 to allow several more witnesses to contact committee members and provide additional information.

There was some discussion among committee members about Representative Burnett's request for postponement. A motion was made by Representative Teague that the Committee postpone action on HB 105 and allow witnesses to provide additional information. The motion passed unanimously.


House Bill 107 was discussed by the Committee. A motion made by Representative Lory to pass House Bill 107, passed unanimously.

Representative Oberg made a motion to put House Bill 107 on the Consent Calendar. Committee members questioned what would be gained by this, and several members objected. Representative Oberg withdrew the motion.
