## Minutes of Meeting

An Executive Session meeting of the Education Committee of the House of Representatives was called to order Friday, January 26, 1979 in Room 5, Capitol Annex at 1:30 p.m., by Chairman, Peter J. Gilligan, Jr.

The roll was taken and shows all members present.

HOUSE BILL 140: Representative Pistoria moved that the committee DO PASS HB 140. The motion was discussed and question called. The motion failed, 11 voting no and 6 voting yes. The motion was reversed to DO NOT PASS and carried (11-6).

HOUSE BILL 142: A motion was made to amend the bill on line 19 by striking "hours" and inserting "class periods". This amendment was discussed and a vote of the committee shows it failed unanimously. Representative Nordvedt moved that the committee DO PASS HB 142. The motion was discussed and question called. The motion failed, 13 voting no, 4 voting yes. The motion was reversed to DO NOT PASS and carried (13-4).

HOUSE BILL 162: It was moved by Representative Oberg to DO PASS. The motion carried 13 to 4.

HOUSE BILL 175: Representative Pistoria moved to AMEND HB 175 so that "September 10" will replace "September 1, or the first official pupil instruction day of the district." The motion passed unanimously. Representative Uhde moved the committee AS AMENDED DO PASS. The motion carried, 13 voting yes, 4 voting no.

HOUSE BILL 217: Representative Lund moved to AMEND HB 217 so it will not require third-class school districts not maintaining a high school to be audited. The motion passed, with one committee member voting no. Representative Kemmis moved AS AMENDED, DO PASS. The motion carried, 16 voting yes, 1 voting no.

The meeting adjourned at 2:35 p.m.
