

JUDICIARY COMMITTEE
EXECUTIVE SESSION
February 1, 1979

The meeting was called to order following the regular meeting at 9:10 a.m. in room 436 of the Capitol Building on Thursday, February 1st, 1979. Chairman Scully presided. All members were present with the exception of Representative Eudaily, excused.

HOUSE BILL NO. 355: Mr. Scully told the members that he had checked and the code bill had repealed the sections under discussion in this bill. He said he would give the legal opinion to Representatives Keedy and Kemmis and after they have had a chance to study it see if they feel that it is worth going with a committee bill to reinstate them. They will report back.

HOUSE BILL NO. 426: Representative Conroy moved "do not pass". There was discussion about benefits and who will be penalized. etc. Representative Day commented that this was one of the most unreasonable bills that has come before this committee. Several other members said that they agreed. The motion carried with the vote unanimous.

HOUSE BILL NO. 432: Representative Lory moved "do pass". Representative Keedy moved to amend the title and lines 12 and 15. (copy attached) The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Lory then moved "do pass as amended". The motion carried with the vote unanimous.

HOUSE BILL NO. 438: Representative Kemmis moved to amend page 1, line 18, following, cost, insert, ; benefit impact. There was much discussion about changing the amendment to read, net economic impact. The question was called on the original amendment and the motion failed.

Representative Keyser moved "do pass". The motion carried with the vote unanimous.

HOUSE BILL NO. 238: Rereferred to committee. Copy of statement of intent must accompany standing committee report, and must be voted out unanimous. Carried.

The meeting adjourned at 10:40 a.m.
