Following the regular meeting the committee went into executive session to take action on pending bills. All members were present except Representative Teague. The meeting was called to order at 8:40 a.m. by Chairman Scully in Room 436 of the Capitol Building.

HOUSE BILL NO. 424:

Representative Lory moved to amend page 5, lines 18 and 19, to strike all of the new language. Also strike "such" and insert "the".

The motion carried with the vote unanimous.

Representative Keedy moved to amend page 5, line 13, by striking "or property owners". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. There was some discussion about whether it includes a bar owner and it was decided that it did.

Representative Lory moved "do pass as amended" and the motion carried with the vote unanimous.

HOUSE BILL NO. 443: There was some discussion about the rate of interest and the intent of the bill. Representative Daily moved "do pass" and the motion carried with Representative Keyser voting "no".

HOUSE BILL NO. 456:

Mr. Scully said that they would hold this bill until everyone on the committee has had time to study it thoroughly. There was some discussion about the method of appointment.

The meeting adjourned at 9:50 a.m.

Mr. Scully asked if the members wanted to send a gift to Representative Ralph Eudaily who is in the hospital, St. Patricks in Missoula. This will be done.
