## HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE 46th Legislature

## 6 February 1979

Chairman Dussault called the meeting to order at 3:50 pm, on Tuesday, February 6, in Room 343. All members of the committee were present.

Chairman Dussault brought to the attention of the committee the new Chapter 11. Representative Moore moved that the chapter be adopted by the full house. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Dussault then brought for the consideration of the committee the problem of drafting request deadlines as they relate to introduction deadlines.

Representative Vincent moved that appropriate language be researched and presented to the committee for consideration.

Representative Huennekens moved as a substitute motion that the Joint Rules be amended as follows:

On page 28, paragraph one:

Strike: "All bill drafting requests must be submitted to the Legislative Council by 5 p.m. on the fourteenth legislative day."

Insert: All drafting requests must be submitted to the legislative council by 5 p.m. four legislative days before introduction deadline for that category of bill or resolution as per the following schedule:

	Drafting Deadline	Introduction Deadline
General bills and resolutions	14th Day	18th Day
Revenue bills	17th Day	21st Day
Committee bills and resolutions	36th Day	40th Day
Appropriations bills and study resolutions	None	None

The motion of Representative Huennekens carried unanimously.

Speaker Gerke brought to the committee's attention the 48-hour deadline for introduction of bills drafted late. Representative Ramirez moved that the rule be changed to state that bills delivered after the deadline must be introduced by 5 pm of the second day following the day of delivery. The motion was amended to make this a House House Rules Committee 6 February 1979, page two

Rule if the Sonate did not agree to making it a Joint Rule. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Dussault then announced that the bills currently in the Rules Committee would be acted on next Tuesday at 1 pm.

Representative Bardanouve asked if Saturday mornings could be reserved for committee meetings, particularly the appropriations subcommittees. Chairman Dussault argeed to checking to see if the schedule could be arranged to accommodate the work of these subcommittees.

Chairman Dussault then adjourned the meeting.
