
Chairman Dussault called the meeting to order at 3:45 pm, Thursday, February 8 in Room 343. All members of the committee were present.

Chairman Dussault brought to the attention of the committee the matter of the amendments on HB 38 introduced by Representative Dozeir.

After lengthy discussion the consensus was that neither the chair nor the Rules Committee has the authority to rule on matters of constitutionality, therefore the Keyser ruling was inappropriate.

The bill would be passed for the day, and if anyone desired they could move the bill into the Rules Committee.
