

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by Chairman Brand, roll call showed that Rep.'s Azzara and Donaldson were not in yet.

HB 286-BRAND-Mr. Christian says that we can TABLE this in favor of HB 606.
O'CONNELL-Let's wait on these and let them get together and have Executive in the morning.

HB 260-SALES moved DO PASS, which carried unanimously.

Rep. Azzara came in.

HB 76-BAETH-moved to amend by changing all references to 2% to 3%, which carried. Baeth then reported that the subcommittee recommended AS AMENDED DO PASS, and so moved, which carried with Baeth voting NO.

HB 436-BAETH gave the subcommittee report and therefore recommended DO NOT PASS, which carried with Kropp, Sales, Porter, Feda and Hayne voting NO.

HB 553-BARDANOUVE moved DO PASS, which carried with Sales voting NO.

Rep. Donaldson came in.

HB 558-BARDANOUVE-I have been told that the different sides are meeting and trying to get a better bill, so I would ask that we pass consideration on this until we hear from those people -- so moved and carried.

HB 561-KROPP moved DO PASS.

KANDUCH made a substitute motion of DO NOT PASS, which carried with Kropp, Sales, Porter, Feda, Hayne, and Johnston voting NO.

HB 567-BAETH moved DO PASS.

JOHNSTON-In the House, the voters have a chance to say what they want every two years.

The DO PASS motion carried 12 - 5 on a roll call vote.

HB 613-FEDA moved DO NOT PASS, which carried with Brand, McBride, Johnston, Azzara, and Kanduch voting NO.

HJR 35-FEDA moved DO NOT PASS.

McBRIDE made a substitute motion of DO PASS, which failed 12 - 4, JOHNSTON moved to reverse the vote to the original motion of DO NOT PASS, to which the committee agreed, so HJR 35 went out DO NOT PASS on a vote of 12 - 4.

HB 419-DONALDSON moved DO NOT PASS, which carried unanimously.


HB 469-O'CONNELL moved to TABLE, which carried unanimously.

HB 492-DONALDSON moved DO NOT PASS, then withdrew his motion and instead asked that the committee hold HB 469 for the time being, which carried.

HB 552-BARDANOUVE moved to take this OFF THE TABLE, which carried. He then moved HB 552 DO NOT PASS, which carried with Sales, Porter, Feda, Hayne and McBride voting NO.

HB 626-O'CONNELL-I just want to TABLE it and let it die here.....which the committee assented to.
