Chairman Scully appointed the following sub-committees:

Representative Eudaily was already appoint as Chairman of the Elections sub-committee and Representatives Uhde and Anderson were added.

For making a composite and study of the sentencing bills, Representative Pavlovici was appointed as Chairman and Representatives Teague, Holmes, and Seifert were added. They are to contact Larry Zanto and get a list from him, as to what bills are where and with the same subject matter.

SENATE BILL NO. 296: Representative Conroy moved "not concurred in". The motion carried with Representatives Lory and Kemmis voting "no".

SENATE BILL NO. 86: Representative Keyser moved "not concurred in". The motion carried with the vote unanimous.

SENATE BILL NO. 293:

Representative Seifert moved "be concurred in". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Seifert will carry on the floor.

SENATE BILL NO. 382: Representative Lory moved "be concurred in". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Pavlovich will carry on the floor.

SENATE BILL NO. 423: Representative Lory moved "be concurred in". The motion carried with Representative Keedy voting "no". Representative Curtiss will carry on the floor.

SENATE BILL NO. 341:

Representative Conroy moved "be concurred in". Representative Keyser moved to amend on Page 2, line 9, insert: "monthly". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. (copy attached) Representative Conroy moved "be concurred in as amended". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Conroy will carry on the floor.

SENATE BILL NO. 232:

Representative Kemmis suggested an amendment. After some discussion Representative Lory moved "not concurred in". Representative Keyser moved a substitute motion "be concurred in". Representative Keedy suggested there should be an amendment on page 3, lines 9, 10 and 11. After more discussion it was decided to wait on the amendments and see how the vote turned out and then amend if necessary. The question was called and on a roll call vote the motion failed by 9 to 7. The vote was reversed and the bill did not pass by 9 to 7.

The bill will be held until it is discussed with the sponsor. He has possible amendments that may change the opinion of the committee.

SENATE BILL NO. 153: Representative Lory moved "be concurred in". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Lory will carry on the floor.

SENATE BILL NO. 291: Representative Keyser moved "be concurred in". Representative Teague presented amendments. (copy attached) Representative Keyser moved the adoption of the proposed amendments, and the motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Keyser moved "be concurred in as amended". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. The bill will be held for the Elections sub-committee to see if it is covered in SB 65.

SENATE BILL NO. 215: Representative Roth moved "be concurred in". The suggestion was made that some amendments would be necessary. Representative Keedy moved to amend page 1, the title, change 12 to 14. The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Kemmis moved to amend on page 2, line 2. The motion carried with the vote unanimous. (copy attached)

Representative Roth moved "be concurred in as amended. The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Keedy will carry on the floor.

Representative Keyser moved "be concurred SENATE BILL NO. 281: in" and the motion carried with the vote Representative Keyser will carry on the floor. unanimous.

Representative Keyser moved proposed SENATE BILL NO. 278: amendments. The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Lory moved "be concurred in as amended". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Kemmis will carry if Representative Dussault does not, since she is one of the sponsors and may be willing to carry it.
