

JUDICIARY COMMITTEE  
EXECUTIVE SESSION

SENATE BILL NO. 261:

Representative Keedy moved "be not concurred in". There was lengthy discussion about dangerous road conditions, I have no feeling to give thme sovereign immunity about design.

Representative Kemmis led a discussion about negligence. Several cases were discussed concerning this.

Representative Keyser moved to amend lines 17 and 18 by striking "maintenance and improvement". The motion failed.

The question was called and the motion "not concurred in" carried with the vote unanimous.

SENATE BILL NO. 149:

Representative Lory moved "be concurred in". The motion carried with the vote unanimous. Representative Uhde will carry.
