

JUDICIARY COMMITTEE
EXECUTIVE SESSION
March 20, 1979

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Scully at 8:00 a.m. in room 436 of the Capitol Building on Tuesday, March 20. All members were present except Representatives Conroy, Day and Teague.

The following action was taken:

SENATE BILL NO. 397 Representative Aubyn Curtiss moved that Senate Bill 397 "be concurred in". Motion carried unanimously of the members present. Representative Curtiss will carry Senate Bill 397 on the floor of the House.

SENATE BILLS 345 AND 495 Representative Roth moved "to table" Senate Bills 345 and 495. Motion carried. Representative Rosenthal voted NO.

SENATE BILL NO. 393 Chairman Scully asked if there were any amendments. Representative Roth said she had a question mark on page 5, by line 22, and Representative Eudaily questioned the stricken language line 22 and on page 12, line 7, there was a word "not". Chairman Scully said it didn't appear the committee was ready to go on this bill and would ask someone to contact Senator Towe and find out if there are any amendments. Representative Holmes said she didn't think he and Dr. Lensink agreed.

Chairman Scully appointed the following members as a subcommittee on any amendments and report back to the full committee:

Rep. Lory
Rep. Holmes
Rep. Keyser

SENATE BILL NO. 202 Chairman Scully said this bill is in regards to an extra judge and it was his opinion there should be another district.

Representative Seifert made a motion to create a new district of Lake, Sanders and Mineral counties. There was a brief discussion by the committee. A vote was taken with 9 yes and 5 no of the members present. Representative Keedy abstained. Motion carried.


