The meeting was called to order by Acting Chairman Senator Hims1 at 9:10 A.M. All members of the Committee were present.


Senator Hims1 then stated that the meeting had been called as a work session for HB 528. Representative South, the sponsor of HB 528, stated that the bill should be amended to exempt blue collar workers, teachers, and clerks from this bill. Their status should remain mandatory negotiable items under the Collective Bargaining Act, he explained. He then asked Mr. Gosnell if he had amendments to this end.


Mr. Gosnell, Administrator of the State Personnel Division, submitted amendments with the proper language to exempt this special group of employees. A copy of these amendments are attached.

Representative South then moved the amendments to HB 528 do pass. This motion carried unanimously. Senator Lockrem then moved that as amended HB 528 do pass. This motion carried with a 9 to 1 vote, with Representative Tropila placing the dissenting vote. It was the concensus of the Committee that Senator Lockrem should carry HB 528 on the Senate floor.

The Committee discussed when would be the best time to meet to discuss HB 891, the pay plan bill. It was decided that they meet on Friday, March 30, at 7:30 P.M. in room 108 to hear this bill.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:25 A.M. by Senator Hims1.
