Chairman Stephens called the meeting to order at 9:10 am in Room 331. Senators Hazelbaker, Jergeson, Mathers, Thiessen Turnage, Stephens, Representatives Dussault, Gerke, Huennekens, and Moore were present. All other members of the committee were absent.

The matter before the Joint Rules Committee was whether or not a line item Senate amendment was in order even though the House had killed a bill with exactly the same substance. Senator Lockrem was recognized to explain the reasons he brought the matter to the attention of the Joint Rules Committee.

Representative Dussault called to the attention of the committee Joint Rule 6-8 which reads as follows:

No bill may be introduced or received in a house after that house has finally rejected a bill during that session designed to accomplish the same purpose save upon approval by the rules committee of the house in which the bill is offered for introduction or reception.

Following a discussion Representative Dussault moved that this question be moved to the House Rules Committee for a determination in accordance with Joint Rule 6-8. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Stephens adjourned the meeting.
