

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE
MONTANA STATE SENATE

January 5, 1979

Meeting of the Legislative Administration Committee was called to order by Chairman Kolstad on the above date at 1:15 p.m. in Room 415 of the State Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL: All committee members were present except Senator Graham.

MOTION: Motion was made by Senator Brown to up-grade the watchmen's salaries from Grade 5, Step 3, to Grade 5, Step 4, and Grade 5, Step 5. The motion was seconded by Senator Hazelbaker and carried unanimously.

MOTION: It was moved by Senator Hazelbaker and seconded by Senator Rasmussen to increase the grade step of Louise Sullivan, Asst. Chief Steno and Committee Secretary, to a Grade 10, Step 7, because of the extra duties she performs. Motion carried unanimously.

DISCUSSION: Senator Brown brought up for discussion the question of a researcher position for the Minority Leader of the Senate and it was decided by the committee that a researcher would be shared with another committee of their choice with the provision that Senator Blaylock should choose the researcher. The other researcher is to be shared by Senator Mathers, President of the Senate, and the Judiciary committee. Senators Mathers and Lensink will choose the researcher.

MOTION: Motion by Senator Hazelbaker and seconded by Senator Brown that all attaches' salaries are to be increased by 1 step up to 3 years of service.

The committee adjourned upon motion by Senator Hazelbaker and seconded by Senator Brown.
