The first meeting of the Business & Industry Committee was called to order by Chairman Frank Hazelbaker on January 10, 1979, in Room 404 of the State Capitol Building at 10:00 a.m.

ROLL CALL: All members were present.


Chairman Hazelbaker introduced Marjorie Nichols, Committee Secretary, and Bob Pyfer, Attorney from the Legislative Council.

Chairman Hazelbaker stated there were a number of bills from The Office of the Insurance Commissioner that needed to be sponsored, and he asked members of the Committee to select the bills they wished to sponsor. The Committee members agreed to do this. Senator Hazelbaker also stated he would like to have all of the bills from The Insurance Commissioner's Office heard on the same day in order to expedite matters. Committee members concurred.

Chairman Hazelbaker said he would rather post bills further than three days ahead so people traveling a distance would have a better opportunity to attend the meeting.

Senator Regan brought up the problem of "junk" telephone calls. Senator Kolstad said this would be hard to police.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:30 a.m. The next Committee Meeting is scheduled for Friday, January 12, 1979, at 10 a.m. when SB 73 will be heard.
