The meeting of the Business and Industry Committee was called to order by Chairman Frank Hazelbaker on the above date in Room 404 of the State Capitol Building at 10:00 a.m.

ROLL CALL: All members were present except Senator Bill Lowe who was excused.

SENATE BILL 81: This bill is an act to provide for a 10-day rescission period on disability insurance policies issued by insurance companies and membership contracts issued by health service corporations: amending section 33-22-201, MCA.

Mr. Tom Harrison had submitted an amendment to the bill and our Staff Attorney, Bob Pyfer, checked the amendment.

Senator Dover moved the amendment be adopted. Senator Goodover seconded the motion.

DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 81: Senator Dover moved the bill DO PASS as amended. The bill was unanimously passed.

SENATE BILL 99: Senator Goodover stated this bill is an act to authorize the Department of Revenue to buy, import, and sell table wine: amending sections 1, 2, 3, and 5 of Initiative 81 and sections 16-1-302, 16-1-303, and 16-1-304, MCA.

There was a brief discussion of the bill.

Senator Goodover moved the bill Do Pass.

QUESTION: Roll Call Vote was taken. The Committee voted 6-4 that Senate Bill 99 DO NOT PASS. A Majority-Minority Report was taken.

ADJOURN: There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
