

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
BUSINESS & INDUSTRY COMMITTEE
MONTANA STATE SENATE

February 14, 1979

The meeting of the Business and Industry Committee was called to order by Vice-Chairman Pat Goodover on the above date in Room 404 of the State Capitol Building at 10:00 a.m. Chairman Hazelbaker had to be present at another meeting for a short time.

ROLL CALL: All members were present with the exception of Senators Lowe and Mehrens who were excused.

SENATE BILL 408: Senator Peterson, sponsor of Senate Bill 408, stated that this bill allows bank officers to close the bank on any day when the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis is not open for business.

PROPOSERS OF SENATE BILL 408: Mr. Harold Pitts, representing the Montana Bankers Association, spoke in support of SB 408.

Mr. Les Alke, representing the Department of Business Regulation, stated that they support the bill.

There were no opponents to the bill.

There was a question and answer period from the Committee.

DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 408: Senator Kolstad moved that Senate Bill 408 Do Pass. Senator Dover seconded the motion. SENATE BILL 408 PASSED THE COMMITTEE. Senator Hager was the only dissenting vote.

SENATE BILL 399: Senator Hager, sponsor of Senate Bill 399, stated this bill is an act to repeal the license fee required of an architect, builder, contractor, or manufacturer, doing more than \$15,000 business per year.

Senator Hager stated that the cost of administering the license fee is too costly.

PROPOSERS OF SENATE BILL 399: Mr. H.S. Hanson, representing the architects, stated they support SB 399.

Mr. Larry Huss, representing the Montana Contractors Association, stated they support the bill.

There were no opponents to Senate Bill 399.

There was a question and answer period from the Committee.

DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 399: Senator Dover moved that Senate Bill 399 Do Pass. The Committee voted unanimously that SENATE BILL 399 DO PASS.

SENATE BILL 359: Senator Regan, sponsor of Senate Bill 359, explained the bill to the Committee. She stated that this bill, in essence, abolishes the quota system for alcoholic beverages.

There were no other proponents of SB 359 present at the hearing.

OPPONENTS OF SENATE BILL 359: Mr. Thomas Lythgoe, owner of the Bluestone Restaurant in Helena, spoke in opposition to SB 359. Mr. Lythgoe stated this bill would be of no benefit to him.

There was a question and answer period from the Committee.

Senator Regan offered several amendments to the bill which will be worked out with Staff Attorney, Bob Pyfer.


No executive action was taken on SB 359.

DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 191: The hearing for this bill was heard on January 29, 1979.

Senator Goodover moved that Senate Bill 191 Do Not Pass. Senator Regan made a substitute motion that Senate Bill 191 Do Pass. A Roll Call Vote was taken on the motion to pass Senate Bill 191. The Committee voted 5-3 that SENATE BILL 191 DO NOT PASS.

The Committee decided to wait until a later date to take action on Senate Bill 302.

ADJOURN: There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
