CONSIDERATION OF HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 69:

Chairman Lensink asked Representative Waldron open the discussion and presenting the resolution to the committee. This is a resolution requesting an interim committee to study child abuse.

Senator Palmer explained that this had to be redrafted causing it to be rather late in the introduction. Judy Carlson from the SRS recommended that it do pass.

Senator Steve Brown stated that this ties in with SB 301.

Senator O'Hara asked what about the task force that had been assigned to this cause. There seems to be an over-lapping regarding this situation. Sometimes jealousy occurs and coordination is difficult as the different groups don't know what the other is doing.

Senator Lensink stated that this subject has been discussed at great length and felt that he had a difficult time finding justification finding time for this.

Senator O'Hara moved that the Resolution BE NOT CONCURRED IN. Senator Lensink stated that before Senator Galt left, he gave a "NO" vote. Senators Van Valkenburg, Anderson, Steve Brown, Lensink, all voting "NO".
