January 19, 1981

Chairman Fagg convened the Rules Committee at 11:35 a.m. in Room 343. All members were present with the exception of Rep. Menahan.

HJR 4

Rep. Moore made a motion to refer HJR 4 to the Business and Industry Committee. The motion carried unanimously.

HJR 8

Rep. Dussault presented HJR 8 to the committee. Rep. Vincent, Rep. Marks and Rep. Moore also spoke in favor of the Resolution. Rep. Vincent make a motion to pass the resolution. Rep. Dussault made a motion to amend Page 2, line 3, after the word "determine", insert:"among other options". Rep. Dussault's motion carried unanimously. Rep. Vincent made a motion to pass HJR 8 as amended, Rep. Moore raised the question and the motion carried unanimously.

HJR 9

Rep. Moore presented HJR 9 to the committee. Rep. Dussault moved to amend the resolution by adding a new paragraph on page 3, after line 20. Line 21 "This resolution will become effective upon passage of HB 82 \_\_\_\_\_. Motion carried unanimously. Rep. Kemmis made a motion to amend Page 2 line 20 as follows:

Page 2 line 20.

Following: "note"

Strike: remainder of line 20


Strike: lines 21 thru 23.

Insert: ", unless further time is granted by the presiding officer or committee making the request based upon a written statement from the Legislative Fiscal Analyst director that additional time is necessary to properly prepare the review. The motion carried unanimously. There was a substitute motion by Rep. Marks to table the resolution as amended and hold it until action is taken on HB 82 \_\_\_\_ by the taxation committee. The motion carried unanimously.

A Motion to write a letter to the Legislative Council and ask them to amend page 9 of the Twelve Orders of Business, last paragraph as this applies to the Senate and the House plans to report adverse committee reports on item of business #2. They should make this change in the handbook.

Rep. Dussault made a motion to DO NOT PASS House Bill 82. This motion carried unanimously. She also made a motion to write a letter to Rep. Iverson indicating we recognize the number of issues that must be resolved and that we suggest that he cause to be introduced another House Resolution on particular subject matter. This motion carried unanimously.
