

The Natural Resources Sub-Committee on HOUSE BILL 16 met on Wednesday, January 21, 1981, in Room 437 with CHAIRMAN SALES, and REP. QUILICI and REP. COZZENS present.

Also present were representatives of the Department of Natural Resources LEO BERRY and ALAN DAVIS. BILL GOSNELL of the Department of Energy was there to represent his department.

JOHN BRAUNBECK and TEX PATE of the IOMA as well as DON ALLEN of the Montana Petroleum Association were present with a list of amendments.

CHAIRMAN SALES referred to Exhibit 1 which is attached. All of the Amendments referred to in that exhibit were accepted by those present from the Department of Natural Resources, the oil industry and the Sub-Committee members.

DON ALLEN of the Montana Petroleum Association presented the attached Exhibit 2. Items 1, 2, 3, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 15 were not changed by agreement of all parties as these items are also covered under Exhibit 1.

After some discussion, the Department of Natural Resources agreed to Items 4 and 14.

The oil industry representatives agreed to omit Items 5, 6, 8, and 16.

All parties agreed that Item 7 be changed so that following classifications the words "other than for petroleum products" be used.


The Department of Natural Resources further agreed to Item 17 as written on Exhibit 2.
